

**1 INTERNATIONAL MISSION BOARD (IMB)**

Christian workers report that the militant Islamist group, Boko Haram, is having a major impact on their work in West Africa. Boko Haram continues its reign of terror in Nigeria with threats to expand terrorist activities into neighboring countries. Even in this atmosphere of violence and uncertainty, the gospel message is going forth and impacting receptive hearts.

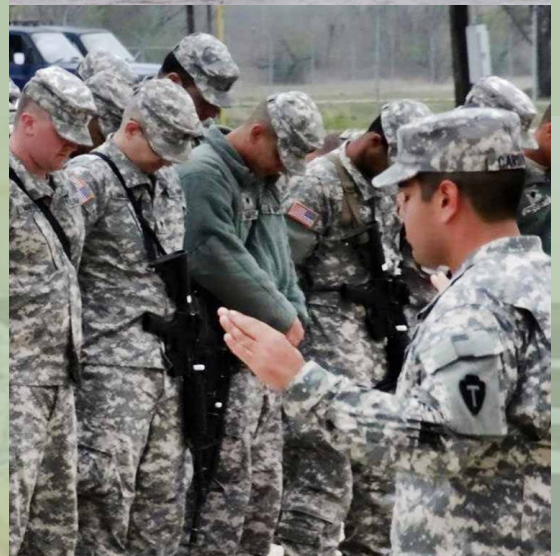

As a child, Major Guillermo Cardona III was raised in a Roman Catholic home.
